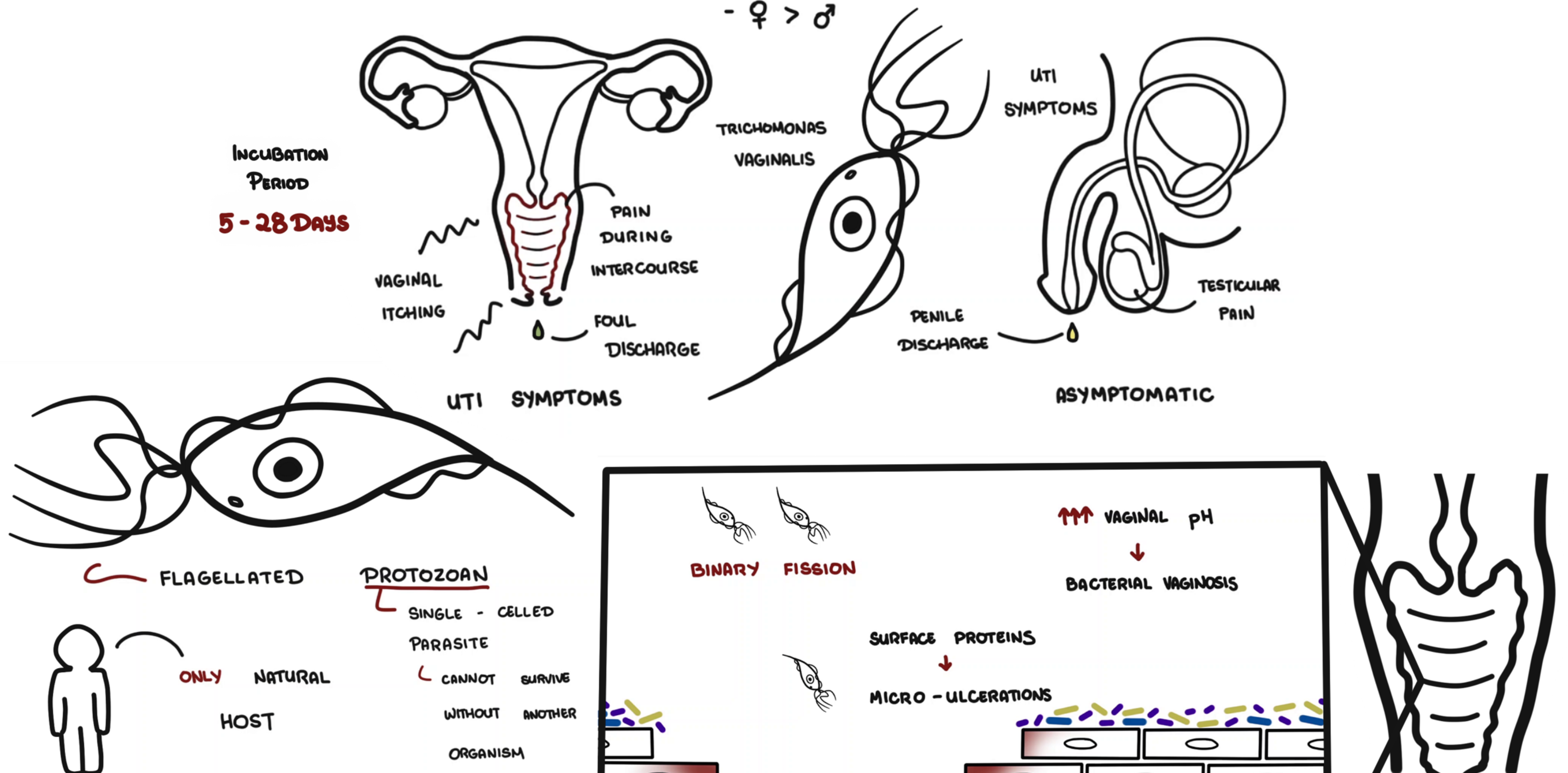

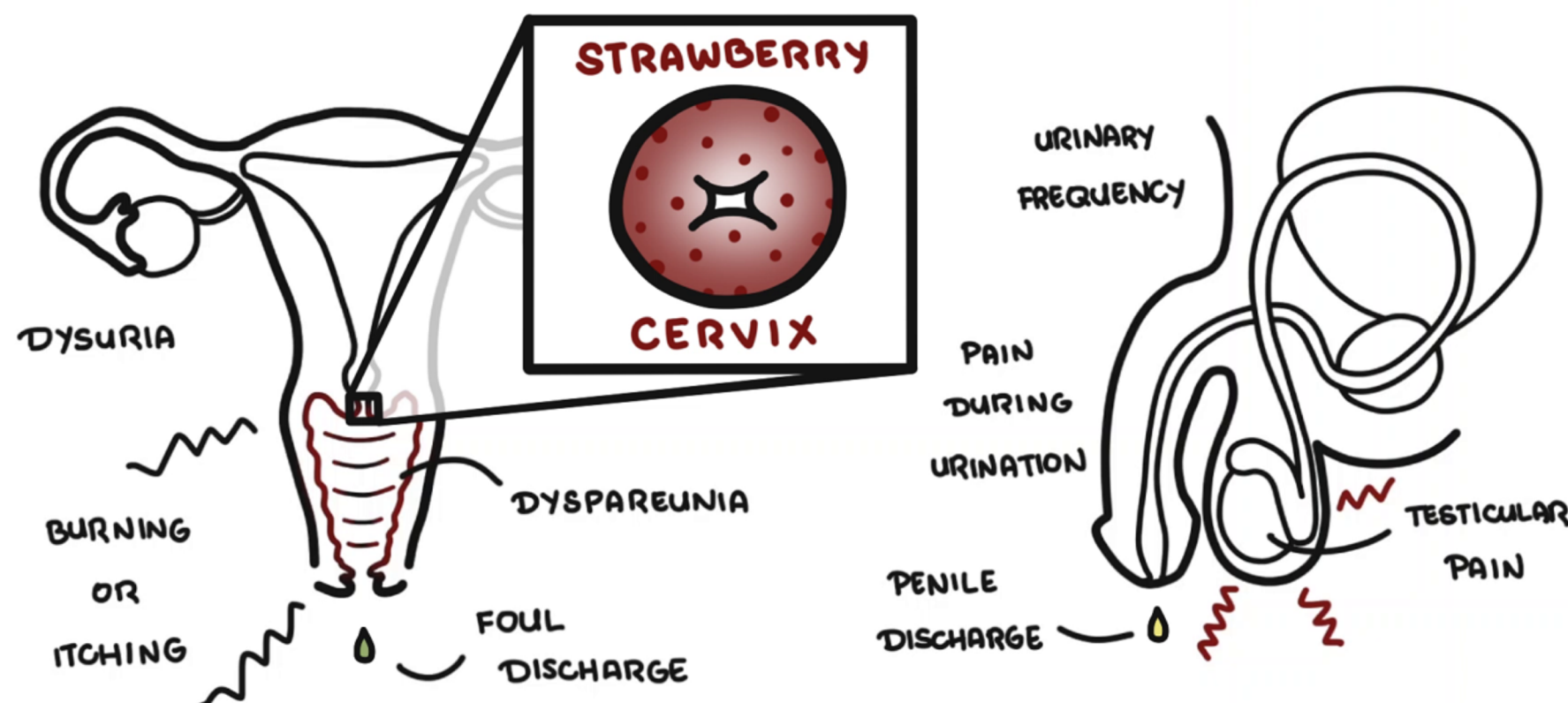

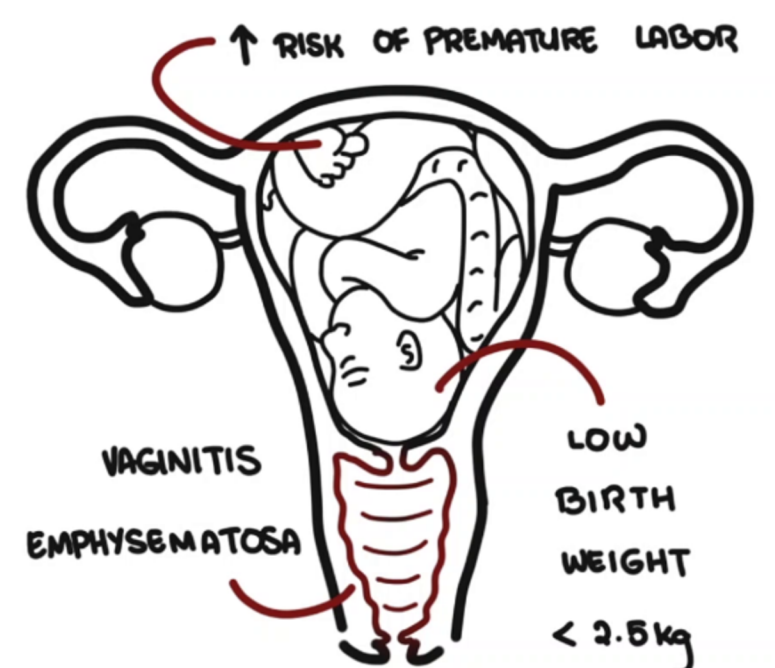
SOME WOMEN BUT MAJORITY OF MEN ARE **ASYMPTOMATIC**



RISK FACTORS

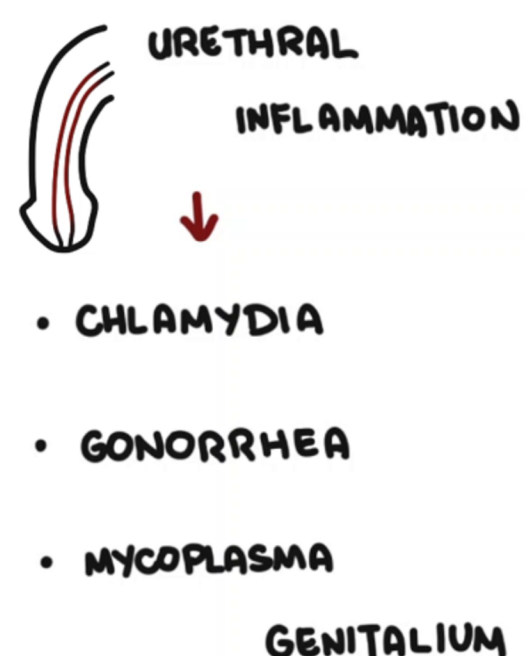
- FEMALE

- CHLAMYDIA

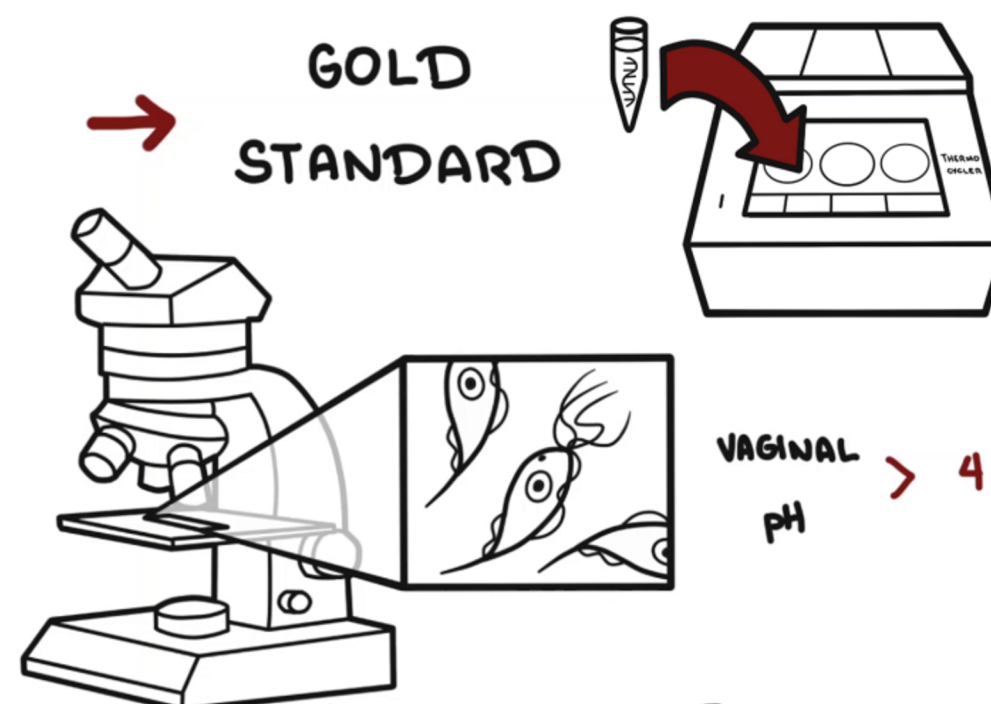


INVESTIGATIONS AND DIAGNOSIS

- CULTURE



TREATMENT

- ORAL METRONIDAZOLE
- ORAL TINIDAZOLE (SINGLE DOSE)

PREVENTION

- USE OF BARRIER CONTRACEPTION
- ROUTINE TESTING
